The Amy Gillett Scholarship 2008

Amy Gillett was a true Australian champion representing Australia at the Atlanta Olympics in rowing and internationally as a champion cyclist. The Nation grieved when she was killed, and her team mates injured, while training in Germany in 2005.

The Amy Gillett Scholarship encourages the development of talent, self-confidence, leadership, sportsmanship and a positive approach to competition, educational pursuits and life, in young female cyclists, consistent with the way in which Amy lived her life.

Each year, in partnership with Cycling Australia and the AIS, the Amy Gillett Foundation provides the opportunity for a rider to join the AIS women's team for competition and training, including overseas racing commitments, under the supervision of the Australian National Coaches.

Ensuring a well-rounded athlete who is cognisant of their life outside cycling, the scholarship also encourages and supports the recipient's further educational aspirations.

The scholarship support provided during the scholarship year, includes:

- Financial assistance with travel, accommodation and expenses while competing overseas with the AIS women's team
- Giant road bike for training and competition, courtesy of Giant Bicycles
- Eye wear products courtesy of Oakley
- Assistance with entry fees and insurance when competing nationally and internationally
- Oversight of training by national coaches
- Access to AIS clinical services during training camps at the AIS.

Applications for 2008 are now open.

The Amy Gillett Scholarship 2008 Application Form

Eligibility & requirements:

- The Amy Gillett Scholarship is open to Australian women from the senior division (ie. must hold a Cycling Australia 'elite' category women's competitive licence for 2008).
- It is not open to women who are current or former AIS cycling scholarship holders.
- Applicants must be available to fulfill the overseas competition program of the AIS women's team and national competition program established in consultation with the AIS/CA National Coaches.

Successful applicant will be expected to:

- Uphold and support the ethos, aims and philosophy of the Amy Gillett Foundation.
- Act as an ambassador to further the aims of the Amy Gillett Foundation. A mutually agreed program will be established with the AGF General Manager via the AGF Athlete Agreement.
- Sign the Cycling Australia Athlete Team Agreement.

Scholarship decision:

- The decision will be made by a selection panel comprising AGF Board members, CA/AIS high performance discipline coaches and the high performance manager. This panel will be selected by the AGF's Scholarship Sub-Committee.
- The selection panel's decision is final.
- The decision of the scholarship recipient will be announced the week commencing 10th March 2008.
